The experiences in this exchange programme looks forth to building new friendships, discovering similarities, respecting differences and instilling self-confidence among the students.



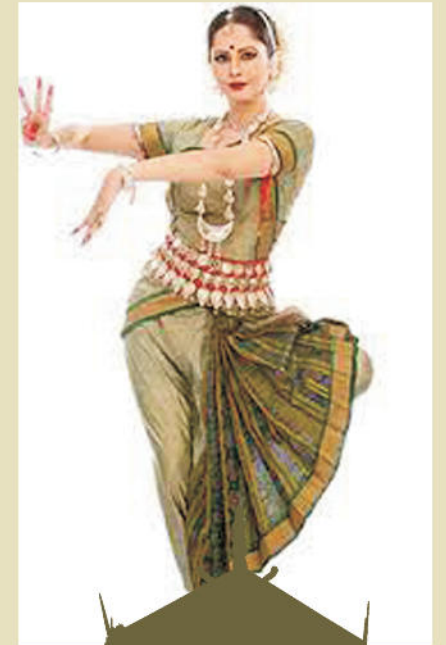
1. MANIPUR-THE LAND OF JEWELS
